**Call for 'Expression of Intent'**  
for Teaching Postgraduate Courses in the  
Department of Political Science

The Department invites colleagues from our constituent Colleges to participate in teaching post graduate courses in the next semester, on a guest lecture/s basis. As per our norms, those colleagues that have a Ph.D or ten years of teaching experience are invited to submit a plain paper application stating an 'expression of intent' for a specific course. They could choose from a list of optional courses available for teaching in the 4<sup>th</sup> semester for MA Final Year students enclosed below. This application must be accompanied by:

1. A complete teaching plan for the course they wish to teach,
2. A topic-wise, detailed reading list

This complete application of three documents should be submitted by 2<sup>nd</sup> January, 2018 to the Department office. Please also note that this will be done as per University guidelines on appointment of the guest lectures.

The second stage of the process may involve an interaction with the HOD and Departmental colleagues on 3<sup>rd</sup> January. The colleagues applying to teach are kindly requested to be available for this, if needed. The Department office will, if need be, individually notify the specific time to all those who submit a complete set of such papers along with their request, by the evening on 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2018.
