Notice for Filling Forms for Optional Papers for MA Final Students

1. Please note that Optional paper forms will be accepted only with effect from 31st July 2017, 9.30am onwards till 5.30pm.
2. The Department office will issue tokens for the first 150 students on a first cum first serve principle on a daily basis for the first two days, that is 31st July and 1st August 2017.
3. The Department office reserves the right to issue more tokens after the first 150 on each day. This would be done no later than 3.30pm every day.
4. While the Department office will try its best to take forms of all 150 students who will be given tokens on that day BUT it is NOT guranteed. In case all tokens are not entertained on the day of issuance, fresh tokens will be issued the next day on a first cum-first serve principle.
5. No forms will be accepted unless these are complete in all aspects with the necessary documents notified in the Department notice.
6. NO proxy submission of forms is allowed under any circumstances.
7. If a student is unable to come to Department; he/she may email his/her request on the Department email id polscience.du@du.ac.in. ONLY those requests which are supported by certified medical certificates (subject to submission of original certificate by 20th August 2017 5.00P.M) will be accepted. The medical certificate must be for the student enrolled in the M.A programme and not that of a family member.

The Department office will record all such requests once every day, at the end of that working day on the first cum-first serve principle.
