His topics of interest include the politics, history and culture of this complex and diverse border region of India, and of the country as a whole. An engineer by training, he is also interested in technology and its impacts on society. Samrat's first book, *The Urban Jungle*, a novel, was published by Penguin Books in 2011, and nominated for the Man Asian Literary Prize. His other publications include short stories, essays, and a graphic novella. Some of his works have been translated variously into German, Spanish, Italian and Portuguese. A volume of writings on Northeast India by writers from the region, which he has edited, called *"Insider Outsider"*, was published in January and is being formally launched at the India International Centre on February 14. The topic is one of great contemporary relevance owing to debates over the Citizenship (Amendment) Bill and the National Register of Citizens.

Abstract

Though Muslims follow the Quran and *Sunnah* (sayings and deeds of the Prophet Muhammad), the teachings of Islam are formalised by theological or jurisprudential schools, called *Fiqh*. Sunnis follow four major schools, *viz.*, Hanafi, Shafi'i, Hanbali and Maliki while Shia Muslims follow the Ja'fari school of jurisprudence. The lecture will focus on the emergence, history and *raison d'être* of these schools.

The speaker, Dr Zafarul-Islam Khan, is an accomplished scholar of Islam who has studied in Cairo's famous Al-Azhar University and has a PhD in Islamic Studies from Manchester University (UK). Besides his many books in Arabic, Urdu and English, he has contributed a number of articles to the *Encyclopaedia of Islam*, a major source of Islamic studies.

Recent international relations scholarship has probed the ways in which international organizations (IOs) struggle to garner legitimacy in contested global governance fields, emphasizing the importance of discourse to institutional legitimation, and the significance of internal, self-legitimation efforts. This paper applies insights from IO legitimation scholarship to an increasingly influential but remarkably under-studied actor: the International Organization for Migration (IOM). Founded outside the UN system in 1951, IOM is now amongst the largest international organizations (IOs) worldwide, and joined the UN system in 2016, but lacks a formal mandate to protect migrants' rights. Many scholars have argued that IOM has thrived because of its place on the margins of the UN, where it could execute restrictive migration management programs on behalf of states, unencumbered by human rights norms and protection obligations. However, in recent years, IOM has adopted human rights discourse and expressed commitment to human rights and humanitarian standards, including in an extensive set of new institutional policies. We analyze this development through the prism of IR theories on the legitimation of IOs. The contribution is three-fold. First, we trace the evolution of IOM's human rights discourse and identify key themes in this rhetoric, highlighting its bridging of rights-talk and management-speak; its constitution of particular groups of "vulnerable" migrants IOM then positions itself to assist; and its blending of rights commitments and fledgling advocacy efforts with continued deference to states. Second, we provide a fresh account of *why* IOM has acted this way, considering these developments as part of an institutional legitimation strategy that aims to strengthen IOM's perceived legitimacy internally and in the eyes of key constituents, particularly states and other international organizations. Third, we use the case to challenge and refine theories of IO legitimation.
